- 1 Corinthians 15: 14, 17 If Christ has not been raised from the dead, then you cannot trust God!
- 1 Corinthians 15:20 But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead.

Jesus Predicts His Resurrection

John 2:19 - The temple will be destroyed and built again in 3 days Mark 8:31 - After 3 days he will rise again.

Matthew 12:39-40 - The sign of Jonah

Matthew 27:63 - The soldiers knew of Jesus' prophecy

Yet, no one was waiting for his resurrection! Why?

Fulfilled Scriptures

Matthew 27:62-66 - Soldiers guarded the tomb because Jesus said he would rise in three days.

Matthew 28:6 - Jesus has risen "as he said."

Mark 16:7 - The angel said, "There you will see him, just as he told you."

Luke 24:6-8 - "Remember how he told you..."

Luke 24:13-27 - Jesus interpreted all the Scriptures concerning himself.

Luke 24:36-46 - Jesus opened their minds to the Scriptures while they disbelieved.

Christ's resurrection happened exactly according to the Scriptures. What God says, He will do.

Exodus 13-14 - God sent them a more difficult route so that their eyes would be on his glory instead of their enemies.

The resurrection proves who Jesus is — "And Jesus Christ our Lord was shown to be the Son of God when God powerfully raised him from the dead by means of the Holy Spirit." Romans 1:4
No matter what you face today, Jesus is still Lord.
Luke 24:32 - Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?
