

Are We Still Under the Sabbath Laws?
Exodus 20:7-11 - 3rd & 4th Commandments
March 15, 2023

3rd Commandment - You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain

The expectation here is not merely to not use God's name improperly, but the emphasis is to rightly represent him.

God's name is tied to His glory - Exodus 33:18-20, 34:5-8

4th Commandment - You shall remember the Sabbath, to keep it holy

Three Types of OT Laws:

1. Ceremonial (Religious) Laws
 - A. Food Laws - Clean/Unclean
 - B. Mark 7:14-23

2. Civil (Social Laws)
 1. Numbers 23 - Cities of Refuge

3. Moral (Ethical Laws)

What did the Sabbath actually command? :: Exodus 20:8-11

1. Keep it holy and "to the Lord"
2. Work six days and rest on the seventh

Three Primary Views

Seventh Day Sabbath - Moral law that all should keep.

Christian Sabbath - It is a moral law but has some ceremonial aspects to it, which included being on the 7th day.

The Sabbath Was Fulfilled in Christ

Sabbath Fulfilled

- Colossians 2:16-17
- Romans 14:5-6

Christians Begin to Meet on the Lord's Day

- Acts 20:7, 1 Corinthians 16:1-4

So how do we obey the Sabbath today? :: Hebrews 3:7-4:10

What does the Lord's Day look like? :: Hebrews 10:24-25
