

<u>A word from our Pastor</u>

Camellia Family, we are almost there! When I presented the vision on January 31st for our **Camellia 2021: Investing in a Fruitful Future** campaign, I proposed that we work and sacrifice to have our building paid off in 6 months, which would be by the end of July. As of today, only 3 months later, our total stands at \$12,411.71. We are a matter of just a few weeks until we've reached that goal. Let's not take it easy just because the end is in sight, but let us push harder until that debt is at \$0!

The second part of our campaign was our **Every Member in Ministry** initiative. I praise the Lord for your response! Over these next few weeks, we will begin organizing these different ministries and get them up and running. So if you signed up to serve I thank you, and I ask you to be patient with us as we strive to get everything structured and organized.

There are a few different ministries for which we need more volunteers. We need vastly more volunteers for our nursery. Right now, our nursery workers serve one week a month. I desire that we have so many nursery volunteers that each one only works once every 3 months. That means that we need all hands on deck! We need more people serving our young families by loving on their babies. As our church grows, this ministry will become more and more critical. Young families will only join our church if they are comfortable leaving their children in our nursery. That means we need workers! Please see Shanasi Smith or Janet Eikenberry about volunteering.

We also need more volunteers for our Sound & Media Ministry. We currently only have 4 people who are working on this team, and we need several more. Even if you are not a technological wiz, we still need you. We will train you and get you equipped before expecting you to serve in this role. Please speak to me, Paul, or one of our current ministry volunteers if you are willing.

Camellia, thank you for your faithfulness! I'm excited to see how the Lord will use us in the future when we are faithful to His Word and willing to serve!
