"Thank You Church"

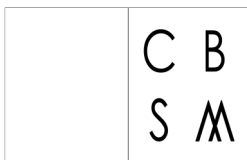

A word from our Pastor

Camellia Family,

As I have now been here at Camellia for a little over two years, I look back over my short time here, and I am thankful. The Lord has blessed us mightily, and I look forward to His continued blessings in the future.

As we enter into this Fall season, a season regularly associated with giving thanks, I am so thankful for what the Lord has done and is doing at Camellia. One of the verses that has been a driving force in my ministry has been Colossians 3:16: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God."
