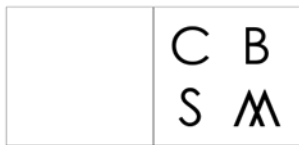

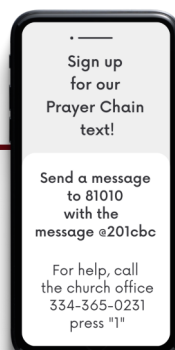
"Ascribe to the Lord the Glory Due His Name"

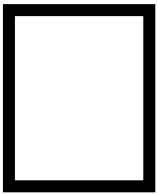
