Hebrews 6:19 says that God's promises are
an anchor for our souls.

In this world, Jesus tells us, there will be
trouble. We know that. We expect it.
Storms of life come upon those who are
faithful as those do for those who are
unfaithful. But when storms hit, we have
the promises of God's Word to anchor us
and carry us through.

One of the most prominent promises
throughout Scripture is the promise that
God is with us. This truth should affect
how we respond while in the storms. For
example:

Isaiah 41:10 states, "fear not, for I am with

will strengthen you, I will help you, I will
uphold you with my righteous right hand."

And we see this again in Philippians 4:6-7,

to it:

Philippians 4:5b-7, "The Lord is at hand; do

made known to God. And the peace of
God, which surpasses all understanding,
will guard your hearts and your minds in
Christ Jesus."

The reason we can have peace that
surpasses all understanding is because the

because of that, we can pray to Him about
everything. This truth anchors us in the
storms of life. The Holy Spirit uses this
truth to uphold us and sustain us.
