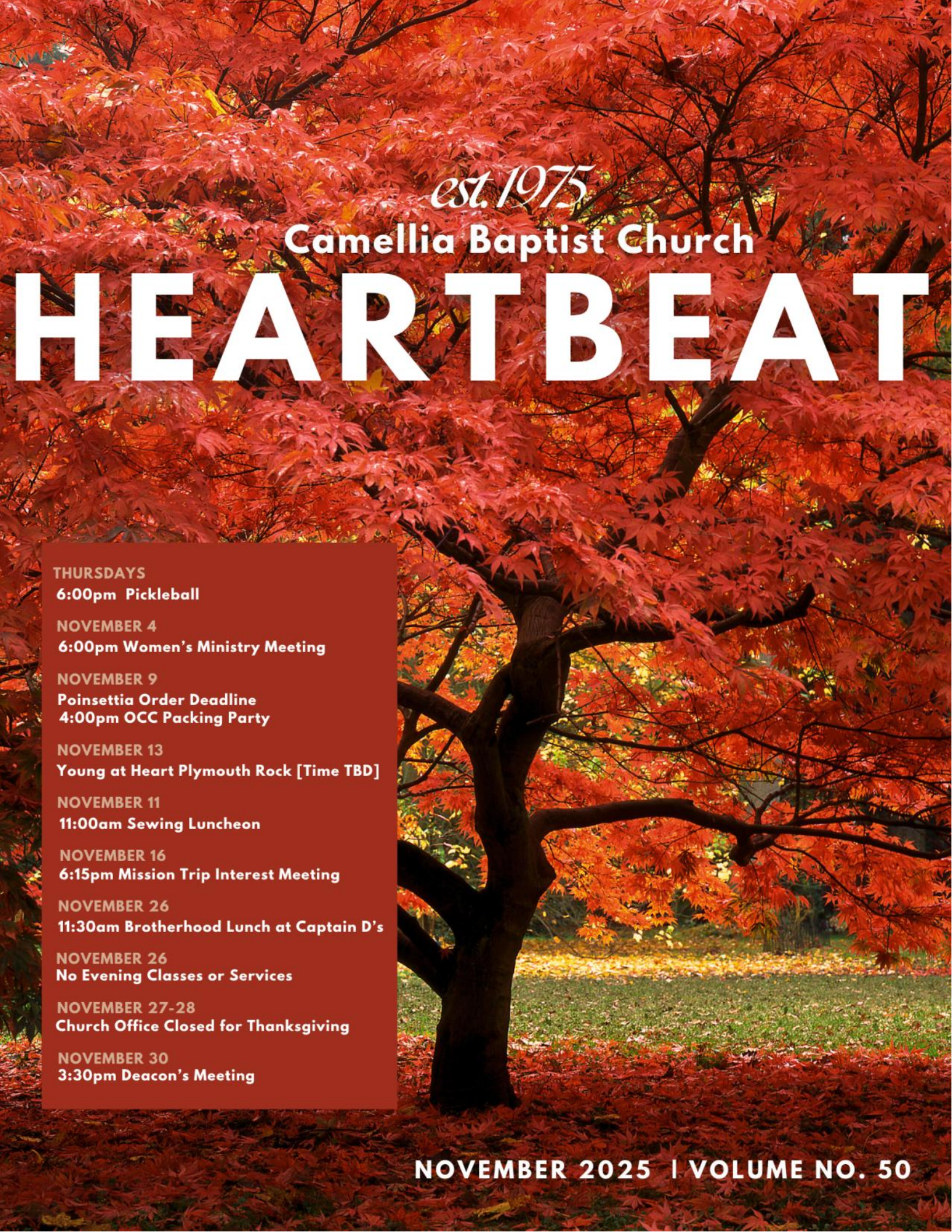

Camellia Family,

The holiday season is upon us, which means that Christmas is right around the corner. With the Christmas season comes a significant emphasis within SBC churches: the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for International Missions.

The typical month that this is most strongly emphasized is December, but at Camellia, we begin our Lottie Moon emphasis in November. Our goal will be \$25,000 once again this year. We have surpassed our goal four of the last five years, including twice when our goal was also \$25,000. I am confident that we will do the same once again this year.

To meet this goal, each family in our church should average giving \$168. Over the months of November, December, and January, that averages out to \$56 per month. I know that finances are tight for many, but \$56 a month for 3 months is a small sacrifice to make so that the Gospel can be taken to the nations.

For those of you who might know, the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering is the primary means of financial support for our International Mission Board. Every penny of this offering goes to the missionaries. It pays for things like housing, vehicles, schooling for missionary children, medical care, and much more. Because our missionaries do not have to worry about financial support, they can focus their attention on sharing the Gospel with those who need Jesus.

There are over 7,200 unengaged and unreached people groups in the world. This means that those people groups range from 0% to 2% Christian. 3.39 billion people live in these groups. That's 41.8% of the world's population. Camellia, there is a lot of work left to be done. That is why I trust that we will make the sacrifice of \$56/month for 3 months this holiday season!

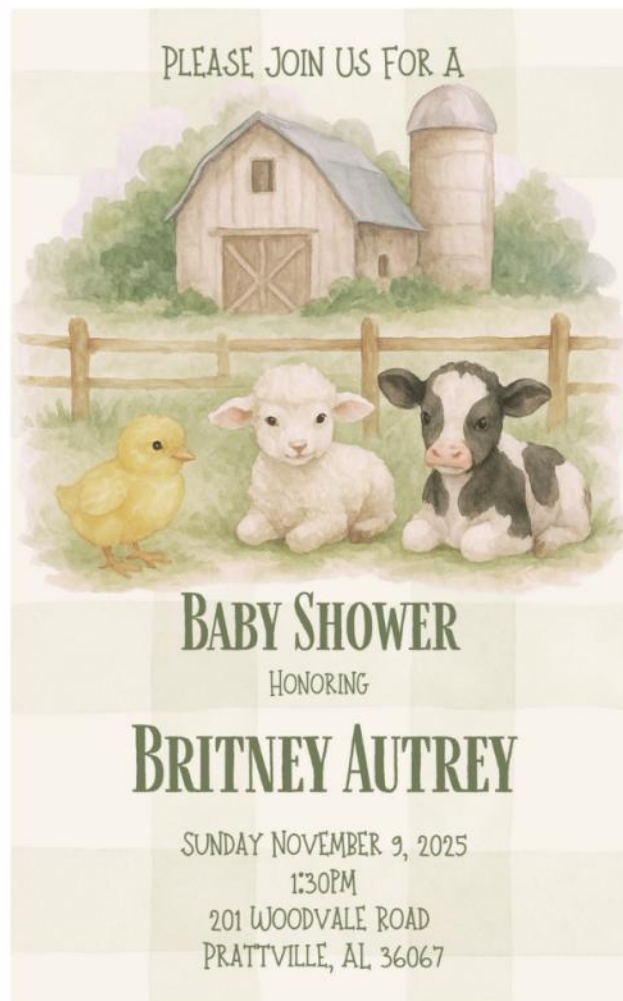

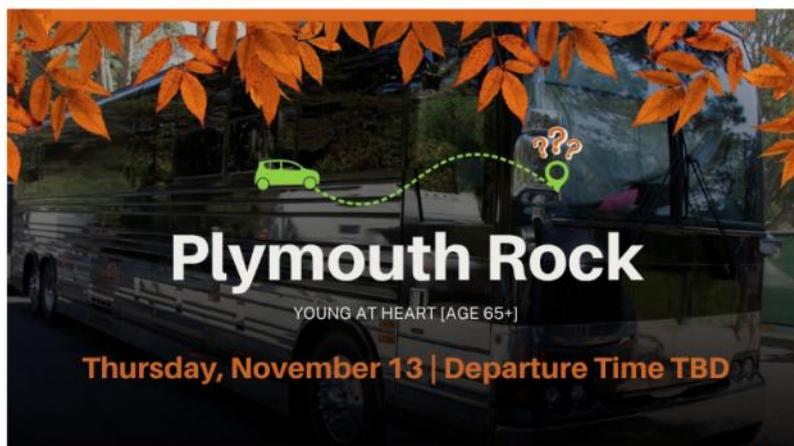
