

A word from our Pastor

Camellia family, what a wonderful day we had on May 23rd, celebrating the Lord's faithfulness to us in paying off our CLC loan! Our vision for Camellia 2021: **INVESTING IN A FRUITFUL FUTURE** was for us to have the building paid off in 6 months, but you did it in just over 3 months! I praise the Lord for you and your continued faithfulness!

In light of us paying off the building, I wanted to address a few things. First, because of your faithfulness in paying off this loan as quickly as you did, we can hire another full-time pastor. As a prospective Associate Pastor of Music and Ministries comes in view of a call on June 12th & 13th, and as his family prepares to move to Prattville, please be in prayer for him, his wife, and his children. While this is an exciting time for them, it can also be very stressful. Please pray for them to have a smooth transition and for this move to help our church to continue to grow healthier and pleasing to the Lord.

Secondly, I know that many have been giving to the CLC building loan for many, many years, and others have begun giving to it over these last few months. Now that we have paid off the building, many have asked what you can do with that money. Here is what I, as your pastor, want to encourage you to do: include that money in with your offering to the general budget.

I will teach and preach about this more in the months to come, but I want to explain my reasoning briefly. First, in Scripture, we don't find a separation between our tithes and our offerings. For many people, we view our tithes as what we give to the general budget and our offerings are what we give extra to different things within the church. But as we look to the Bible, there is no difference in tithes and offerings. The call of Scripture is for us to give sacrificially and cheerfully as the Lord blesses us. We are not called to differentiate in tithes and offerings but rather to give cheerfully and sacrificially to the Lord.

The church has nominated a Stewardship Committee to guide our church in how we handle our money. And our Stewardship Committee here at Camellia is top-notch. You have appointed a group that handles the Lord's money very faithfully. When we designate our offerings instead of giving to the general budget, we limit our Stewardship Committee's ability to use that money most wisely. We need to trust our committee to be wise and discerning in how they allocate money. Giving to the general budget shows trust in the Lord and in this committee.

Lastly, giving to the general budget allows that budget to grow in the future to meet more needs. When we only give what is necessary to "meet budget," then our budget will never grow beyond what it currently is. But when we give cheerfully and sacrificially, regardless of what our budget is, we have the opportunity to give over and beyond our needs to increase that budget for the future years.

So, as you pray and consider where to give the money you've been giving to the CLC loan, I pray that you will consider just adding that in with what you've been giving to the general budget. Let's give cheerfully and sacrificially, regardless of how large or small our budget is. Let's trust the Lord and our Stewardship Committee to be wise and discerning with how the money can best be used within our church. And, let's give for the future. Giving to the general budget allows these things to happen.
