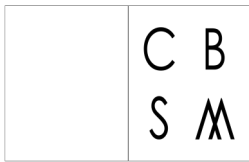
**Message from our

A word from our Pastor

Church family, I have been very thankful for your response to the vision I laid out for *Reach Camellia* in my sermon on August 14th. Many of you share my desire to reach the community of Camellia Estates, and you have had that desire for a long time. Camellia Baptist Church was started in 1975 for the very purpose of reaching Camellia Estates with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. And, for many decades we were successful. But over these last two decades, things have changed. It is time for Camellia Baptist Church to fulfill her mission and once again reach Camellia Estates.

On September 11th, at 4:00 we will have a training meeting in the CLC fellowship hall. I greatly encourage all participants to be a part of this meeting. That is the job of the Holy Spirit. So we pray that the Holy Spirit will work through us and use *Reach Camellia* to shine the light of the Gospel upon Camellia Estates.
