

Message from our **Associate Pastor of Music & Ministries**

With Resurrection Sunday upon us, one question comes to mind: how can we have assurance in the final resurrection of all the redeemed? The apostle Paul addresses in 1 Corinthians this question with the church in Corinth. 1 Corinthians 15:20 says, "But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep."

Just as the first ear of corn that sprouts (firstfruits) is the sign of the harvest to come, Christ's resurrection (firstfruits) is the sign of the final resurrection of the dead that is to come. Paul tells us that we can have this assurance because just as sure as Christ was resurrected so will all the redeemed be raised from the dead.

As the choir sang last Sunday:

"Come behold the wondrous myst'ry; slain by death, the God of life. But no grave could e'er restrain Him. Praise the Lord, He is alive! What a foretaste of deliverance, how unwavering our hope. Christ in power resurrected as we will be when He comes."
