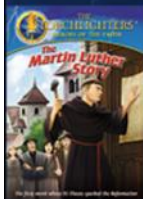

In Matthew 28:18-20, Jesus lays out for us the church's mission. He says that we are to go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.

Along with worshipping our Lord corporately and in our personal lives, this is the essential task and mission of the church. Simply put, if we are not doing this, we are not doing what the Lord wants.

As your pastor, it fills my heart with joy to see how we obey this command within our church.

We are participating in this mission in several ways. First, we have shown great faithfulness financially. Camellia Baptist Church gives 5.5% of all of our undesignated receipts to the Cooperative Program, which funds Southern Baptist missions through the North American Mission Board and International Mission Board. We gave over \$26,000 to Lottie Moon and over \$6,000 to Annie Armstrong to also directly fund these mission boards.

We have also been faithful in not just giving but also going. In March, we sent eight church members to Chiriqui, Panama, to serve alongside IMB missionaries there. On July 22nd - 29th, we will send ten church members to Panama City, Panama, to serve alongside more IMB missionaries. These ten will be Joe & Ann McNeal, Peyton & Kayla Kelly, Don & Renee Neal, Blake & Kortney Turner, and Chris & Leslie Morgan.

Please pray for each of these as they prepare for the trip. For both of these trips, we also have shown great faithfulness in how we have supported them financially. If you would still like to give to support this trip, you can do so throughout July.

Lastly, we have been so faithful here in Prattville. Back in August & September, we sent out over 40 people each Sunday to pray with Camellia Estates. Many of you still pray for and reach out to your "ones" from our "Who's Your One?" initiative. And so many more have been faithful in just inviting others and talking to people about Jesus.

Camellia, this is the mission of the church. We have been so faithful, but much more work must be done. Let's commit to praying for how we, as a church, can continue to show greater and greater faithfulness to this mission in the coming year.

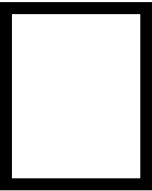
