Lastly, we have been so faithful here in Prattville. Back in August & September, we sent out over 40 people each Sunday to pray with Camellia Estates. Many of you still pray for and reach out to your "ones" from our "Who's Your One?" initiative. And so many more have been faithful in just inviting others and talking to people about Jesus.
