Message from our Associate Pastor of Music & Ministries

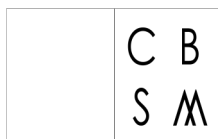
Solomon, the wisest man to ever live, wrote these words in Psalm 127:3-5:

“Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD, the fruit of the womb a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior are the children of one’s youth. Blessed is the man who fills his quiver with them! He shall not be put to shame when he speaks with his enemies in the gate.”

Did you catch how Solomon depicts a man with children? Solomon describes “the man who fills his quiver with them” as “blessed”. We live in a culture today that devalues life. Children are seen as a hinderance or an inconvenience so much so that it is lawful to end the life of a child inside their mother’s womb. The Bible paints a different picture of children. Solomon refers to children as a “heritage”. Though parenting has its challenges, the rewards greatly outweigh the burdens.
