

Camellia Family,

It is crazy that 2026 is already here. For many people, the coming of a new year is a time of hope. For some, 2025 was not a year to be remembered. It was one that brought pain, heartache, and difficulty. 2026 represents the opportunity for a change in circumstances. For others, though, 2025 was a positive year, and they hope 2026 brings even greater prosperity. But this view of the New Year is not biblical. The flipping of a calendar does not guarantee that you will rid yourself of trials in your life. In fact, God regularly reminds us that we WILL have problems. In 1 Peter 4:12, Peter tells us not to be surprised when the fiery trial comes upon us as though something strange were happening to us. Jesus told us in John 16:33 that in this world there will be trouble.

I do not say these things to burst your bubble as you look forward to a new year, but I do want us to think biblically about life. A new calendar year does not bring a change in circumstances. It does not fix problems. It does not change adversity into prosperity. It also does not bring hope. It might promise hope, but a new calendar year cannot deliver on that promise. As Christians, we derive hope from a much more certain place.

Romans 15:4 says, "For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope." Then in Romans 15:13 Paul says, "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope."

God's desire for you is that, as we enter into 2026, you may abound in hope. But we must be certain from where that hope originates. That hope originates from the God of Hope who has given us His Scriptures as anchors for our souls, filling us with endurance, encouragement, joy, and peace in believing. God indeed wants you filled with hope in 2026. God wants you to prosper in hope! But our hope is not merely that a new year will bring new circumstances. But our hope is twofold:

1. God has overcome the trouble through Jesus, and we will not live for eternity with this trouble. This trouble is temporary. Our glory in heaven will be eternal.
2. We don't have to wait until heaven to abound in hope. God has given us His Holy Spirit and His Holy Scriptures, and if we believe His Scriptures and their promises, and we depend on His Holy Spirit to strengthen us to obey those Scriptures, then we can respond to our circumstances with joy and peace even now.

Church, I look forward to a year marked by endurance, encouragement, joy, and peace. I look forward to a year in which our church abounds in hope. But we must remember that our hope is not in the new calendar year. Our hope is in Jesus! I pray that Camellia will lead the way in shining this light throughout our city.
