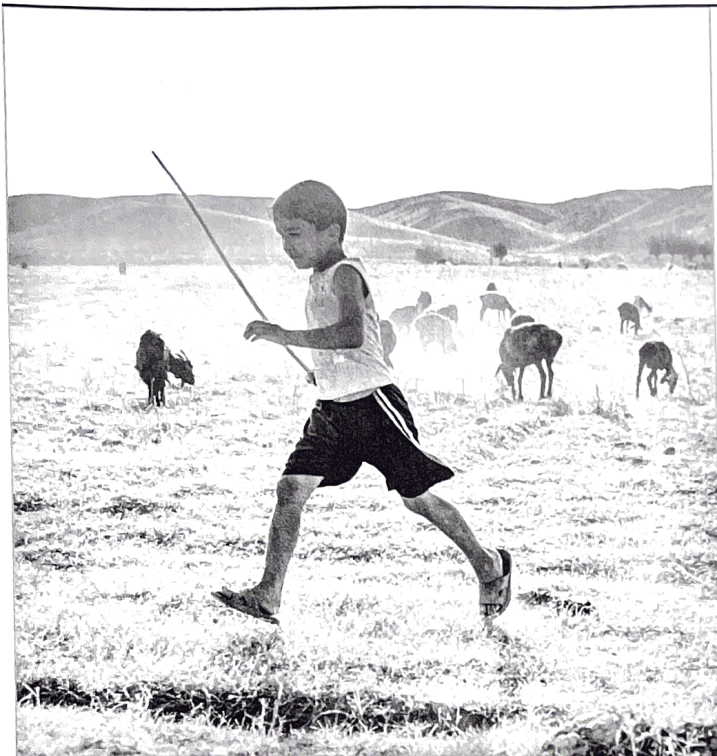


Meet the Special Workers December 2023
