HIGH AMONG THE SNOWCAPPED PEAKS AND fragrant eucalyptus trees of the Andes mountains, missionaries work to reach the lost peoples of Peru with the gospel. Despite the barriers of language and animistic belief systems, they strive to disciple and mobilize Peruvian believers to spread God's Word. By hosting a kids' club every week with their local church, leading a Bible study for moms, ministering to those who have experienced trauma, and getting involved in a local soccer team, they build

relationships they pray will lead to changed lives in the name of Christ. Though they have only been in Peru a short time, they are already seeing God work. While none of the women who attend the weekly Bible study are Christ followers, they enthusiastically tell others about it and even help make food for the children who attend the kids' club. The missionaries testify, "Although they aren't believers yet, these women are essential to the gospel going out to the next generation in their community."
